

## Lakeside Marching Band Marching Band/Color Guard 2018 Letter of Commitment

(Due April 16, 2018)

I understand that I will be asked to become part of a vibrant, diverse group of students who help make the school a better place, and that I will be expected to have fun and become a better musician. I realize that I will be helping myself, my band, my school, and my community by sharing my talents in this way. I also understand that because the marching band is the most visible part of the band program (and often the only contact that many people in metro Atlanta will have with our school) I must act as an ambassador for Lakeside and its values at all times. As a member of the Marching Band/Color Guard at Lakeside, I understand that it will be a time-intensive, sport-like atmosphere, and that I will be required to attend camps on the following dates:

April 21 and 28 – Colorguard Audition Clinic May 29 (Tues) - Spring Training 9am-4pm
Jun 4 (Mon) - Summer practice 4pm-6pm
Jun 11 (Mon) - Summer practice 4pm-6pm
Jun 18 (Mon) - Summer practice 4pm-6pm
Jun 25 (Mon) - Summer practice 4pm-6pm
Jul 2 (Mon) - Summer practice 4pm-6pm
Jul 9 (Mon) - Summer practice 4pm-6pm
Jul 17 (Tues) - PreCamp 6pm-9pm (may change)
Jul 19 (Thurs) - PreCamp 6pm-9pm (may change)
Jul 23-27 - Band Camp (Mandatory)
Jul 31 - Practice 4pm-6pm
Aug 2 - Practice 4pm-6pm

I also understand that if I do not attend these camps, I may not be able to march in the competitions, may be treated as an alternate in the marching band, or may be placed on a non-native instrument to fill a hole in the drill. I understand that the drill for the show is written for a specific number of instruments ahead of time, and if I turn this form in late, I may be placed in an open spot in another section to fill an available space.

Most importantly, I understand that marching band is an activity which involves the needs of the group above the needs of the individual, and I agree that, as we have no bench and no substitutions, all members are of equal importance to the activity. Any absences on my part will, of necessity, diminish the group.

Marching Band/Color Guard Membership is \$500 for the 2018 Marching/Color Guard season. A check for \$100 made out to LBA (Lakeside Band Association) will need to accompany this letter as a first payment. This is due April 16, 2018 to ensure a spot on the field. The remaining \$400 will be payable in 2 payments of \$150 and one payment of \$100 on the 15<sup>th</sup> of May, June, and July. If you choose to pay the complete balance by June 15th, you will receive a 10% discount and your total payment will be \$450. If you have a financial hardship, please contact Mr. Fairchild. Payments can be given to Mr. White or Mr. Fairchild during the school year. During the summer, mail these to Lakeside High School (3801 Briarcliff Rd, NE Atlanta, GA 30345) or use our online payment option via CHARMS once initial deposit has been received. The biggest regret that band students have at Lakeside is missing out on Marching Band their freshman year! Start the year off with the best group of friends at Lakeside! Don't miss your chance!
